**RE: Privacy Act and FOIA Request to Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) for Records Regarding
Surveilling of Tulsi Gabbard, Quiet Skies, and the Quad S Program**

Dear PA/FOIA Officer:

This letter is a request (“Request”) in accordance with the Privacy Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552a *et seq.*, the Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”), 5 U.S.C. § 552 *et seq.*, and corresponding department/agency implementing regulations. The Request is made by the American Center for Law and Justice (“ACLJ”).¹ **The ACLJ represents Ms. Tulsi Gabbard and submits this Privacy Act and FOIA request on her behalf.**

Privacy Act Authorization

Pursuant to the Privacy Act, Ms. Gabbard makes the following authorization:

On this 15th day of August, 2024,

1. I, Tulsi Gabbard, do hereby authorize Department of State to release any and all records and documents naming or otherwise concerning myself to my attorneys and representatives, the undersigned attorneys for the American Center for Law and Justice.
2. I declare, certify, verify or state that, under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States of America, the foregoing is true and correct.

Background

This Background addresses the subject, timeframe, names of any individuals involved, a contract number (if applicable), and reasons why the requester believes the Department may have records on the subject of the request.

According to whistleblower information:

[S]everal Federal Air Marshal whistleblowers have come forward with information showing that former U.S. Representative and Presidential candidate Tulsi Gabbard is currently enrolled in the Quiet Skies program. Quiet Skies is a TSA surveillance program with its own compartmentalized suspected terrorist watchlist. It is the same program being weaponized against J6 defendants and their families. Quiet Skies is allegedly used to protect traveling Americans from suspected domestic terrorists..²

“The whistleblowers first shared the information with Sonya LaBosco, the Executive Director of the Air Marshal National Council (AMNC), a national advocacy group for the Federal Air Marshals (FAMs).”³ According to LaBosco, “Gabbard is unaware she has two Explosive Detection Canine Teams, one Transportation Security Specialist (explosives), one plainclothes TSA Supervisor, and three Federal Air Marshals on every flight she boards.”⁴ Further,

according to LaBosco, Gabbard’s enrollment in Quiet Skies is likely politically motivated. Air Marshals were first assigned to Gabbard on Jul. 23, a day after she criticized Kamala Harris, Biden, and the National Security State in an interview with Laura Ingraham. FAMs were mobilized on Jul. 24 and assigned to their first flight with her on Jul. 25.⁵

In the name of national security, “an individual is enrolled in the program without knowledge. Teams of Federal Air Marshals are assigned to individuals, following and tracking them from when they enter the airport and then on all their flights and transits until they reach their destination.”⁶ Also, “[e]nrolled individuals usually have a Quad S (SSSS) on the bottom right-hand corner of their boarding passes, but not always. They are often flagged for extra searches, frequently so lengthy that they miss their flights.”⁷

Other media outlets are beginning to cover this story.⁸

Records Requested

For purposes of this Request, the term “record” is “any information” that qualifies under 5 U.S.C. § 552(f). The term “record” also includes, but is not limited to, all relevant information created, stored, received or delivered in any electronic or digital format, e.g., electronic mail, instant messaging or Facebook Messenger, iMessage, text messages or any other means of communication, and any information generated, sent, received, reviewed, stored or located on a government *or private* account or server, consistent with the holdings of *Competitive Enter. Inst. v. Office of Sci. & Tech. Policy*, 827 F.3d 145 (D.C. Cir. 2016) (rejecting agency argument that emails on private email account were not under agency control, and holding, “If a department head can deprive the citizens of their right to know what his department is up to by the simple expedient of maintaining his departmental emails on an account in another domain, that purpose is hardly served.”).

When this Request names a person or an office, it includes any alias or pseudonym name and any electronic communication account any such official might use.

For purposes of this Request, and unless otherwise indicated, the timeframe of records requested herein is April 1, 2019, to the date this Request is processed.

For purposes of this Request, the term “Quiet Skies”; “Silent Partner”; “Secure Flight”; “Quad S”; “SSSS”; include any other name, identification term, pseudonym, etc., which might be used by any CIA official.

Pursuant to the Privacy Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552a *et seq.*, and the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552 *et seq.*, the ACLJ hereby requests that the CIA produce the following:

1. Records within the custody of any CIA official – all of an appointee or GS-13 level or higher, or a personal staff or assistant of any such official – naming or otherwise involving Tulsi Gabbard **AND** any of the following:
 - a. Quiet Skies;
 - b. Silent Partner;
 - c. Secure Flight;
 - d. Quad S or SSSS.

2. Records of any communication, briefing, or other exchange of information between any CIA official – all of an appointee or GS-13 level or higher, or a personal staff or assistant of any such official – and any member of Congress or congressional staff, naming or otherwise involving Tulsi Gabbard **AND** any of the following:
 - a. Quiet Skies;
 - b. Silent Partner;
 - c. Secure Flight;
 - d. Quad S or SSSS.

3. Records of any communication, briefing, or other exchange of information between any CIA official – all of an appointee or GS-13 level or higher, or a personal staff or assistant of any such official – and any White House, WHO, or EOP official or staff, naming or otherwise involving Tulsi Gabbard **AND** any of the following:
 - a. Quiet Skies;
 - b. Silent Partner;
 - c. Secure Flight;
 - d. Quad S or SSSS.
4. Records of any communication, briefing, or other exchange of information between any CIA official – all of an appointee or GS-13 level or higher, or a personal staff or assistant of any such official – and any DOJ or FBI official or staff, naming or otherwise involving Tulsi Gabbard **AND** any of the following:
 - a. Quiet Skies;
 - b. Silent Partner;
 - c. Secure Flight;
 - d. Quad S or SSSS.
5. Records of any communication, briefing, or other exchange of information between any CIA official – all of an appointee or GS-13 level or higher, or a personal staff or assistant of any such official – and any TSA official or staff, naming or otherwise involving Tulsi Gabbard **AND** any of the following:
 - a. Quiet Skies;
 - b. Silent Partner;
 - c. Secure Flight;
 - d. Quad S or SSSS.
6. Any record containing information used to justify included Tulsi Gabbard in any of the following programs:
 - a. Quiet Skies;
 - b. Silent Partner;
 - c. Secure Flight;
 - d. Quad S or SSSS.
7. Records within the custody of any CIA official who is an appointee or GS-13 level or higher, or a personal staff or assistant of any such official, containing the name “Tulsi Gabbard” (or any alias or term used for Tulsi Gabbard) and “Kamala Harris” (or any alias or term for Vice President Harris), which are not responsive to any preceding request.
8. Records within the custody of any CIA official who is an appointee or GS-13 level or higher, or a personal staff or assistant of any such official, naming or otherwise involving Tulsi Gabbard, which are not responsive to any preceding request.

Each request seeks records which include, but are not limited to, any record located on backup tapes, archives, any other recovery, backup, storage or retrieval system, CIA electronic mail or message accounts, non-CIA electronic mail or message accounts, personal electronic mail or message accounts, CIA servers, non-CIA servers, and personal servers, as well as any electronic mail or message carbon copied to agency account recipients, any electronic mail or message carbon copied to non-agency account recipients, any electronic mail or message forwarded to agency account recipients, any electronic mail or message forwarded to non-agency account recipients, and attachments to any electronic mail or message.

CONCLUSION

If this Request is denied in whole or in part, the ACLJ requests that, within the time requirements imposed by FOIA, you support all denials by reference to specific FOIA exemptions and provide any judicially required explanatory information, including but not limited to, a *Vaughn* Index.
