Re: Linchpins of Liberty, et al. v United States, et al. – No. 13-cv-777 (D.D.C.) – Preservation of Communications with Lois Lerner

Dear Senator Schumer,

As you are likely aware, the above-referenced litigation is currently pending in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia. One of the named defendants in the lawsuit is Lois Lerner, former Director of the IRS Exempt Organizations Division. In light of the recent revelation that the IRS has apparently "lost" information, including extra-agency email communications, that was stored on the computer of Lois Lerner, we are writing on behalf of plaintiffs in the above-referenced lawsuit to request that you take the necessary steps to ensure preservation of any and all communications between yourself (or any member of your staff communicating on your behalf) and (1) Ms. Lerner or (2) any other IRS official in the Exempt Organizations office between January 1, 2009 and the present. With regard to emails, such preservation extends to communications sent and received through official government email accounts and any other email accounts over which you maintain custody or control.
