Dear Sir or Ma'am:

Under the Maryland Public Information Act Title 4, the American Accountability Foundation (AAF) makes the following request. Specifically, we are requesting copies of the following records:

Please provide copies of records, ideally in an excel or CSV format, showing all fields in the Supplemental Voter Registry created by the CHARTER AMENDMENT RESOLUTION NO. R-04-20 - AMENDING ARTICLE V OF THE TOWN CHARTER TO PROVIDE FOR NON-CITIZEN VOTING AND ESTABLISHING A SUPPLEMENTARY VOTER REGISTRY.

SEARCH AND PRODUCTION

Please search for responsive records regardless of format, medium, or physical characteristics. We seek records of any kind, including paper records, electronic records, audiotapes, videotapes, photographs, data, and graphical material. Our request includes without limitation all correspondence, letters, emails, text messages, facsimiles, telephone messages, voice mail messages, and transcripts, notes, or minutes of any meetings, telephone conversations, or discussions. Our request also includes any attachments to emails and other records. If it is your position any portion of the requested records is exempt from disclosure, AAF requests that you provide it with an index of those documents similar to that required under *Vaughn v. Rosen*, 484 F.2d 820 (D.C. Cir. 1973) or a similar privilege log. If some portions of the requested records are properly exempt from disclosure, please disclose any reasonably segregable non-exempt portions of the requested records. If it is your position that a document contains non-exempt segments, but that those non-exempt segments are so dispersed throughout the document as to make segregation impossible please state what portion of the document is non-exempt, and how the material is dispersed throughout the document.

Please provide all responsive documents as attachments to emails to the address [REDACTED]. For electronic records please provide them in their original electronic format and for paper documents, please provide them as PDF attachments to the email. If document sizes will exceed the capacity of email attachments, please email me and I will provide a location for uploading documents or will

provide storage media to share the documents. Please provide records on a rolling basis as they become available and do not wait to provide all records as one production.

FEE WAIVER

If there are any fees for searching or copying these records, please inform me if the cost will exceed \$50. However, I am also requesting a waiver of all fees because the disclosure of the requested information is in the public interest. There have been serious and numerous examples of voter fraud in Prince George's County related to non-citizens voting. The information you provide will allow AAF to conduct oversight over ascertain whether Cheverly is facilitating illegal voting. Much as the agency ethics offices conduct investigations, it is vital that the public through journalists and watchdog groups be enabled to conduct similar investigations. I am the founder of and write for the American Accountability Foundation. The American Accountability Foundation (AAF) is a charitable and educational organization that conducts non-partisan research and fact-checking so Americans can hold their elected leaders and public institutions accountable. The AAF is staffed by experienced researchers and public affairs officials who would analyze and disseminate the information. Further the AAF utilizes the websites AmericanAccountabilityFounation.com and BidenNoms.com to distribute the original research that would result from the documents requested. Additionally, the staff of AAF have close relationships with reporters and policy makers who would amplify the findings associated with the requested documents. The AAF is a non-profit organization organized under section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code. For these reasons the AAF satisfies the criteria for a fee waiver.
