RE: CPRA Request to examine California Department of Justice records regarding Proposition 39 (Initiative 25-0007A1 or Initiative 25-0007)

Dear Public Records Coordinator:

Under the California Public Records Act, pursuant to Code Section 7920, *et seq.* ("CPRA"), the American Center for Law and Justice (ACLJ) requests certain records regarding Proposition 39, originally titled: "Establishes additional voter identification and citizenship verification requirements. Initiative constitutional amendment" but now titled "Prohibits citizens from voting unless they present government-issued identification. Initiative constitutional amendment"

For purposes of this Request, and unless otherwise indicated, the timeframe of records requested herein is September 1, 2025, through the date of receipt of this Request. All terms used herein have the definitions given by the CPRA.

The ACLJ requests copies of the following records be provided via email:

1. All records addressing or about Proposition 39's Title and Summary of September, 19, 2025.
2. All records addressing or about Proposition 39's Title and Summary of July 3, 2026.
3. To the extent not responsive to request item ##1-2 above, all records addressing or about the changes made to Proposition 39's Title and Summary whether concerning the Title and Summary of September, 19, 2025 or July 3, 2026.
4. To the extent not responsive to request item ##1-3 above, all records addressing or about Proposition 39 received from the office of Governor Gavin Newsom or any staff or agent therein, or from Xavier Becerra.

Conclusion

If this Request is denied in whole or in part, the ACLJ requests that, within the time requirements imposed by CPRA, the custodian agency support all denials by reference to specific CPRA exemptions and provide any statutorily or judicially required explanatory information.

If there are any fees for searching or copying these records, please inform the ACLJ if the cost will exceed \$500. However, the ACLJ respectfully requests a waiver of all fees because the disclosure of the requested information is in the public interest. The ACLJ will disseminate the records requested to the public via multiple media platforms and, as such, the records are requested for news gathering purposes. This information is not being sought for commercial purposes.
