Thank you for sharing Huma's email and phone contact information with Mrs. Shalikashvili. I have been working on connecting General Shalikashvili to Secretary Clinton in hopes that they might speak for a few minutes about a request for her to give the keynote at an event in D.C. in June. I realize that it is quite late in the game, so I have attempted to contact Huma to ask her to reference the Secretary's calendar and see if anytime on June 17 & 18th might be available for this speaking engagement. I certainly understand how busy the Secretary is these days, therefore making Huma quite busy as well. My first attempt to contact her was a week or so ago. I've left both voicemails and sent an email. General Shalikashvili is asking for just a moment of the Secretary's time.
