RE: Request for records regarding Abortion Pill Reversal and the proposed Bill "An act relative to deceptive trade practices" H. 4122.

Dear Custodian of Public Records:

Pursuant to the Massachusetts Public Records Law (Mass. Gen. Laws ch. 66, §§ 10 et seq.), the American Center for Law and Justice (ACLJ)¹ requests records from the Massachusetts Department of Public Health on abortion pill reversal and the proposed Bill "An act relative to deceptive trade practices" H. 4122.

For the purposes of this Request, and unless otherwise indicated, the timeframe of records requested herein is January 1, 2025, through the date of receipt of this Request. All terms used herein have the definitions given by Mass. Gen. Laws ch. 66, §§ 10 et seq.

The ACLJ requests that copies of the following records from January 1, 2025, to the present be provided via email:

- 1. All email communications, meeting notes, or correspondence (including attachments) between officials or staff at the Massachusetts Department of Public Health and representatives of Reproductive Equity Now and/or the Office of Governor Maura Healey that reference or relate to proposed bill "An act relative to deceptive trade practices," H.4122 or "abortion pill reversal."
- 2. All internal reports, memos, briefing documents, or policy analysis prepared by or

for the Massachusetts Department of Public Health regarding abortion pill reversal or proposed bill "An act relative to deceptive trade practices," H.4122.

- 3. All calendar invites, agendas, meeting minutes, or summaries of meetings held between the Massachusetts Department of Public Health that contain the words or phrases: "proposed bill H.4122," or "abortion pill reversal," or "H.4122," or "An act relative to deceptive trade practices."
- 4. Any contracts, grant agreements, or financial disbursements between the Massachusetts Department of Public Health and Reproductive Equity Now (or affiliated entities), including any references to reproductive health initiatives, public outreach campaigns, or legislative advocacy related to the bill "An act relative to deceptive trade practices," H.4122.
- All data, internal statistics, or analysis maintained or produced by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health regarding the use, effectiveness, or outcomes related to abortion pill reversal, and any related policy guidance or public health recommendations.

Fees

If there are any fees for searching for or copying these records, please inform the ACLJ if the cost will exceed \$500. However, the ACLJ respectfully requests a waiver of all fees because the disclosure of the requested information is in the public interest. Conclusion

If this Request is denied in whole or in part, ACLJ requests that, within the time requirements imposed by the MPRL, the custodian agency support all denials by reference to specific IPRA exemptions and provide any statutorily or judicially required explanatory information.

If there are any fees for searching for or copying these records, please inform the ACLJ if the cost will exceed \$500. However, the ACLJ respectfully requests a waiver of all fees because the disclosure of the requested information is in the public's interest. The ACLJ will disseminate the records requested to the public via multiple media platforms and, as such, the records are requested for news gathering purposes. This information is not being sought for commercial purposes.
