Re: Massachusetts Public Records Request Regarding Lobbying for H.5595, “An Act Prioritizing Patient Access to Care”

Dear Ms. Mashni,

Pursuant to the Massachusetts Public Records Law (M. G. L. Chapter 66, Section 10), the American Center for Law and Justice (ACLJ)¹ requests records regarding lobbying for H.5595.

For purposes of this Request, and unless otherwise indicated, the timeframe of records requested herein is January 1, 2023, through the date of receipt of this Request. All terms used herein have the definitions given by M. G. L. Chapter 66, Section 10, *et seq.*

The ACLJ requests the following records be provided via electronic means:

1. All records mentioning or relating recommendations from the Governor of Massachusetts regarding H.5595 of the 194th General Court (“the Bill”).
2. All records mentioning or relating to recommendations from the Attorney General of Massachusetts regarding the Bill.
3. All records mentioning the Bill from the ACLU of Massachusetts.
4. All records mentioning the Bill from Reproductive Equity Now, also called REN.

Conclusion

If this Request is denied in whole or in part, the ACLJ requests that, within the time requirements imposed by the MPRL, the custodian agency support all denials by reference to specific MPRL

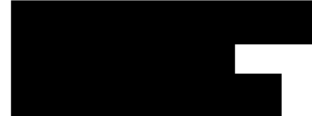
