SUBJECT: Appointment as AR 15-6 Investigating Officer, Fort Liberty Directorate of
Emergency Services (DES) Terror Awareness Slides

1. **Appointment.** You are appointed as an Investigating Officer (IO) pursuant to Army Regulation (AR) 15-6 to conduct an administrative investigation into a 10 July 2024 anti-terrorism presentation by a Fort Liberty Directorate of Emergency Services (DES) Employee. Your responsibilities as IO take precedence over all other military duties.

Coordinate any requests for extensions through your legal advisor, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) will serve as an Assistant IO.

2. **General Instructions.**

a. The purpose of an AR 15-6 investigation is to elicit facts. You are directed to investigate the matters set forth in paragraph 3, below. Your investigation should explore any issues or deficiencies with policy, procedures, resources, doctrine, training, and leadership that might have contributed to these matters. Upon completion of this investigation, you will complete a report of investigation that conforms to the requirements in paragraph 5 of this memorandum and AR 15-6. Provide your report to your legal advisor, who will arrange for a legal review.

b. If, at any time in the conduct of your investigation, something happens that could cause me to consider enlarging, restricting, or terminating your investigation, or otherwise modifying any instruction in this memorandum, immediately report this situation to me, together with your recommendations as to the action I should take.

3. **Scope of Investigation.** You are directed to investigate the facts and circumstances regarding an anti-terrorism training conducted by DES on 10 July 2024. Your investigation will include thorough findings regarding "Terror Awareness" slides that listed non-profit, tax-exempt public advocacy organizations on a section of the slides titled, "Terrorist Groups." In addition to providing a comprehensive 5Ws (who, what, when, where, and why), your findings will answer the following questions:

a. What was the review and approval process for the slides at issue?

b. How long and how many times were the "Terror Awareness" training slides used and approximately how many Soldiers received training using these, or similar, slides?

- c. Were the slides acquired, shared, or presented outside of Fort Liberty?
- d. Is there any evidence of similar training (e.g. discussing non-profit advocacy groups, pro-life beliefs, or animal rights when discussing terrorism) at Fort Liberty?
- e. Were all organizations listed on the slides described as terrorist organizations? How were the tax-exempt, public advocacy groups described?
- f. What actions did the command take after discovery of the training slides?
- g. Are there any additional matters that are relevant to this investigation?

4. Conduct of the Investigation.

- a. Your legal advisor is (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) You will consult with her before beginning your investigation.
- b. Assistant IO, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) will serve as an Assistant IO for this investigation. She is appointed to assist you in conducting interviews and performing other investigative tasks as necessary.
- c. Evidence Collection. Conduct this investigation using the procedures outlined in AR 15-6, chapters 3 and 5.

(1) To the extent possible, witness statements will be written and sworn. You should record witness statements on a DA Form 2823. If it is impractical to obtain a written or sworn statement from a particular witness, you will attest to the accuracy of any transcription or summary of such witness testimony in whatever form it appears. If you do not use DA Form 2823 to record the statement of a witness, check with your legal advisor to determine if you need to furnish a Privacy Act notification.

(2) No witness can be ordered to provide self-incriminating information, or to divulge privileged attorney-client, patient-provider, or similar confidential information. Otherwise, you may order a service member or a civilian employee of the Department of the Army to provide a statement if you believe that the individual has relevant information that would not be self-incriminating. If during your investigation you come to suspect a person may have engaged in criminal conduct, you will consult with your legal advisor. You will not attempt to elicit information from a suspect without first advising that person of his or her rights under the Fifth Amendment of the U.S. Constitution, as described in Article 31 of the Uniform Code of Military Justice. Use a DA Form 3881 to

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document your rights advisement and, as applicable, the witness's waiver of the right to not answer questions or waiver of the right to an attorney.

(3) If your investigation requires an interview with any individual employed under a contract to support the U.S. Army, then you must first submit a request to conduct the interview through the appropriate contracting officer representative. Coordinate this request through your legal advisor.

(4) Where a civilian employee is a member of a bargaining unit and reasonably believes that the inquiry could lead to disciplinary action against him or her, the employee may have a representative from the bargaining unit present during questioning. You will consult your legal advisor if you have any questions regarding these procedures.

(5) Pursuant to AR 15-6, paragraph 3-8d, direct all witnesses who are subject to U.S. Army authority, and request from other witnesses, not to discuss their statements with other witnesses, potential witnesses, or persons who have no official interest in this investigation, until final action has been taken by the approving authority.

d. Unfavorable information. Should you determine during your investigation that a Soldier should be flagged under provisions of AR 600-8-2, paragraph 2-2, notify your legal advisor to verify this. In general, commanders must initiate flags within 3 duty days of identifying a Soldier's unfavorable status, and commanders must notify the Soldier within 3 duty days of initiation. Pursuant to AR 600-8-2, paragraph 2-6, commanders may delay this notification if it would compromise an ongoing investigation. Make a recommendation on whether you believe it is appropriate to delay initiation of the flag in order to avoid such compromise.

5. Report of Investigation.

a. General. Your report of inquiry will be written. Use a DA Form 1574-1, Report of Proceedings by Investigating Officer, and attach all required enclosures and exhibits. You may use AR 15-6, Figure 4-1, as a guide.

b. Assembly. Your completed AR 15-6 preliminary investigation will include:

(1) Table of contents listing all items below, as applicable.

(2) Completed and signed DA Form 1574-1.

(3) Report of investigation with findings, recommendations, and enclosures. Your report will include the following enclosures, as applicable.

- (a) This appointment memorandum (and any supplements to it).
- (b) Written communications with me or my designee, such as requests for, and approval of, extensions of the suspense date.
- (c) Explanation of unusual delays.
- (d) Privacy Act statements.
- (e) Chronology of the investigation.
- (f) Witness list that identifies witnesses in a logical order: witnesses' ranks (if applicable), full names, duty positions, units of assignment, and phone numbers.
- (g) Notification and response concerning adverse information regarding officers.
- (h) Index of exhibits, listing each exhibit that you relied upon. You will include each exhibit as an enclosure to the index.

(4) Findings. You will reach your findings by a preponderance of the evidence. A finding is a clear and concise statement of facts that can be readily deduced from evidence in the record. In your report, develop specific findings addressing the questions in paragraph 3 above and cite the evidence that supports your findings. If evidence conflicts (*e.g.*, conflicting witness statements), make a finding as to which evidence is more credible and why you believe it to be more credible.

(5) Recommendations. Based on your findings, make recommendations as to what changes, if any, are needed in terms of policy, procedures, resources, doctrine, training, or leadership to avoid similar incidents in the future, as well as recommendations concerning other items your investigation revealed. Recommendations will be consistent with and logically based on the findings. Recommendations will be clearly written, feasible, acceptable, and suitable. Each recommendation will cite to the findings supporting the recommendation.

(6) Submission. Submit your report of investigation to your legal advisor for review in Word document format and provide digital copies of all enclosures and exhibits. When finalized, submit your investigation to me, through your legal advisor, in paper copy, and as a digitally signed portable document file. Do not release any portion of this investigation to anyone, other than your legal advisor, without my prior approval. I am the approval authority for this investigation.

SUBJECT: AR 15-6 Investigation Findings and Recommendations – Fort Liberty
Directorate of Emergency Services (DES) Terror Awareness Slides

1. BLUE. On 15 July 2024, I was appointed to investigate the facts and circumstances surrounding Terrorism Awareness training conducted on 10 July 2024, by a Fort Liberty Directorate of Emergency Services (DES) employee. The Terrorism Awareness presentation incorrectly listed several organizations (e.g., People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals (PETA), National Right to Life, and Operation Rescue) on labeled “Terrorist Groups.” Labelling the slide “Terrorist Groups” was a mistake (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) that likely occurred when (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) sev slides from a larger, older presentation. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) inserted group names (not present in the earlier version) into the revised presentation without paying attention to the slide title and without considering how this visually misrepresented what (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) attempting to convey. There was no leadership review or approval of the slides. No evidence suggests that this mislabeling reflected an official Army position or policy nor that these slides were distributed outside Fort Liberty.

2. FACTS. On 10 July 2024, Borrowed Military Manpower (BMM) Soldiers assigned from the (b) (7)(E) received Terrorism Awareness training in preparation for their temporary tasking to provide security at various Access Control Points (ACP) on Fort Liberty (EXHIBIT Z). The training was conducted by (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (EXHIBIT D). (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) with the Fort Liberty Directorate of Emergency Services (DES) (EXHIBIT D). (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (EXHIBIT D). One slide labeled “Terrorist Groups” included “ANTI-ABORTION (National Right to Life and Operation Rescue)” organizations. A photo of this slide was posted on X on 10 July 2024 (EXHIBIT AE). In response this investigation was appointed.

a. Borrowed Military Manpower (BMM) and Department of the Army Security Guard (DASG) Overview

(1) Department of the Army Security Guards (DASGs) provide security at Fort Liberty’s Access Control Points (ACPs), colloquially known as gates. (b) (7)(E) DASGs are augmented by (b) (7)(E), serving as

Borrowed Military Manpower (BMM) gate guards. (b) (7)(E)
(EXHIBIT AB and EXHIBIT C).

(a) (b) (7)(E) the BMM Soldiers serve full-time as gate guards,
(b) (7)(E) Because of this,
they require additional training to temporarily serve as gate guards (EXHIBIT A).
Terrorism Awareness training accounted for 2 out of 54 hours of training. Most of the
training time was focused on tasks associated with operating an ACP like providing
force protection, conducting searches, identifying illegal substances, identifying false
documents, and operating the automated installation entry system. The training also
included 24 hours of ACP on-the-job training (EXHIBIT Z).

(b) BMM is alternately referred to as S3U (Army Soldier Skill Set Utilization) and
Unit Mission Tasks (UMT) (EXHIBIT X). For clarity and consistency, this report will use
the term BMM to refer to Soldiers conducting temporary gate guard duties.

(2) Installation Management Command (IMCOM) training requirements.

(a) An Installation Management Command (IMCOM) 2011 fragmentary order
directed Fort Liberty (then Fort Bragg), Fort Cavazos (then Fort Hood), and Fort Stewart
to establish training for BMM Soldiers who would augment the DASGs. The order
provided minimum training requirements, including Terror Awareness training (EXHIBIT
X). The order provided guidelines for the training and record-keeping requirements. It
also provided these installations the latitude to include additional training tasks. The
order did not provide training resources or products; it directed the training be
developed and implemented locally (EXHIBIT X).

(b) In 2022 IMCOM issued a policy memorandum that set minimum training
requirements for DASG and BMM Soldiers. One change from the 2011 fragmentary
order included removing Terror Awareness training as a requirement (EXHIBIT Y).
Despite this 2022 update, Fort Liberty DES continued to conduct Terror Awareness
training for every BMM rotation. (EXHIBITS A, C)

b. Terror Awareness Training Development

(1) The earliest version of the Fort Liberty (then Fort Bragg) Terror Awareness
presentation is from 2011, used to address the IMCOM training requirement for DASGs
and BMM Soldiers (EXHIBITS D, W, X). No witness in this investigation is aware of how
this 2011 presentation was developed; however, evidence supports that the
presentation was derived from a 2006 United States Army Military Police School lesson
“Terrorism Awareness” (EXHIBIT G). This is based on a recent query of U.S. Army
Garrison – Fort Liberty training lessons conducted around that time, and on the fact that
the 2006 presentation was labeled with the same code (191-5669) listed for Terror

Awareness training directed in the 2011 IMCOM fragmentary order (EXHIBIT G, EXHIBIT X). The 191-5669 code refers to a now outdated program of instruction for Terror Awareness (EXHIBIT AF, AG).

(2) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) adjusted the training presentation over the following six years (2011-2017) to keep the information relevant and current. In 2017, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) made several major modifications to the original presentation including reducing the number of slides and condensing and updating the information. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) based (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) modifications on guidance from (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to keep the information relevant and to base it on open source and published authoritative sources such as documents published by the Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA), Department of Homeland Security (DHS), and the Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI) (EXHIBITS B, C, D).

(3) The 2011 version of the Terror Awareness presentation had 105 slides, with 69 slides covering information on international and domestic terrorist groups. Domestic terrorist groups were categorized as “Left-wing”, “Right-wing”, “Special-interest/Single-issue” and “Others” (EXHIBIT W, slide 74). Slide 99 explained “Special-interest/Single-issue” terrorism by citing “Animal rights”, “Environmental”, “Anti-genetic engineering”, and “Anti-abortion” as examples. The next four slides, 100-103, and the associated presenter notes, further explained only “Animal rights” and “Environmental” domestic terrorist concerns. Besides slide 99, there is no other mention of “Anti-abortion” (EXHIBIT W).

(4) The updated 2017 Terror Awareness presentation contained 45 slides total, with 11 slides covering international and domestic terrorism topics. On slide 17, this presentation classified terrorist groups as international or domestic, with domestic divided into “Left Wing”, “Right Wing”, and “Special Interest/Single-issue”. Slides 17 to 28 of this presentation all used the label “Terrorist Groups” despite some slides including content unrelated to terrorist groups. For example, this section included maps, diagrams, “Left Wing” groups, “Right Wing” groups, and “Special Interest/Single-Issue” groups (EXHIBIT V).

(5) Slides 27-28 were the “Special Interest/Single-Issue” portion of the 2017 presentation. These slides covered what are labeled as “Animal Rights”, “Environmental”, and “Anti-abortion” groups. Slide 27 listed “Animal Rights (PETA and Animal Liberation Front)” and “Environmental (Earth First and Earth Liberation Front).” Slide 28 lists “ANTI-ABORTION (Right to Life and Operation Rescue)” (EXHIBIT V).

(6) While modifying this portion of the presentation, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) searched the internet for (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) as single-issue and special interest groups, adding the first organizations (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) found to these slides. Specifically, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C): “I added the organizations as examples of Pro Life / Pro Choice Groups over the years of modifying the slides in the same manner (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) added examples of Animal Rights and

Environmental Groups...” (EXHIBIT D). (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) used open-source material such as the FBI and DHS “Strategic Intelligence Assessment and Data on Domestic Terrorism”, dated May 2021. This report references Domestic Violent Extremists (DVE) in multiple threat categories to include racially or ethnically motivated violent extremists, animal rights/environmental violent extremists, abortion-related violent extremists, anti-government/anti-authority violent extremists and other domestic terrorism threats (EXHIBIT AA, page 5).

(7) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) made major changes to the Terror Awareness presentation in 2017. From 2017 to 2024 (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) minor changes, like changing Fort Bragg to Fort Liberty and updating events (EXHIBIT D).

(8) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) who modified the slides. DES leadership did not review or approve the slides after modifications (EXHIBITS A, B, C, D).

c. Training Delivery

(1) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) for the Terror Awareness class since (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (EXHIBITS C, D). Approximately (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) per year, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) for DES, teaches the course (EXHIBIT E).

(2) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) claims that when (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) the section of the training dealing with special interest and single-issue organizations (slides 27 and 28 that show animal, environmental and anti-abortion groups), (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) clarified that these single-issue groups can have “individual bad actors within the group that believe in their cause so passionately...and their views can and have in the past become extreme and they will commit an act of terrorism in order to try and further their cause.” (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) claims (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) never classified these single-issue groups as terrorist organizations (EXHIBIT D).

(3) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) taught this training (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) did not have a clear recollection of how (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) taught this section of the class (EXHIBIT E).

d. Training Oversight

(1) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) serves as the (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) for DASG and has been in this position for (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), while responsible for training oversight, exercised no oversight of this training (EXHIBIT F). (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) serves as the (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) for DES and (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) is responsible for the ACP Security Guard Academy and all mandatory courses for BMM Soldiers. While (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was aware that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) reduced the size of the presentation in 2017, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) did not (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) review the course instruction (EXHIBIT C).

(2) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) oversaw and periodically inspected the BMM and DASG training program, however they did not inspect individual presentations (EXHIBITS A, C).

(3) While (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) is “certain” (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) or some DES leadership attended the Terror Awareness training, there is no other evidence that DES leadership did so (EXHIBITS A, B, C).

e. Training Impact

(1) Approximately 9,100 Soldiers received the 2017 version of the Terror Awareness training from 2017 to the present date (EXHIBITS B, C). This calculation is based on an average of 1,200 students trained per year combined with 2024 number thus far (EXHIBIT B).

(2) Following each of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) distributed Interactive Customer Evaluation (ICE) cards (customer feedback cards) to solicit feedback. Each Soldier and DASG is asked (not required) to fill out a card. The input is subsequently entered in an ICE database. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)

(EXHIBITS AC, AD).

(3) A sample of 14 Soldiers who attended the training between March 2024 and July 2024, were interviewed for this investigation. The majority of sampled Soldiers (12) had difficulty recalling specifics of the Terror Awareness presentation (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). Two Soldiers who attended the training in July had some recollection of “Anti-abortion” and “Environmental” groups being classified as terrorist groups. (EXHIBITS H-U).

(4) There is no evidence the Terror Awareness presentation was used for anything other than training DASGs and BMM Soldiers. There is no evidence this presentation was shared outside of Fort Liberty (EXHIBITS B, C, D).

f. Command Actions

(1) Following the discovery of inaccuracies in the Terror Awareness presentation the Fort Liberty DES took the following actions:

(a) Stopped teaching Terror Awareness as part of the BMM training. Further directed that BMM Soldiers will be required to be current on their Antiterrorism Level 1 mandatory training.

(b) Directed a review of all DASG and BMM training to ensure it is presented and executed in accordance with DA policy, regulation, and guidance (completed 14 JUL 24).

(c) Directed appropriate legal reviews of DASG and BMM training prior to execution (completed 16 JUL 24).

(d) Directed a re-validation of DASG BMM instructors prior to the next BMM training course.

(e) Directed DES senior leader attendance at the next BMM training course.

(f) Directed periodic checks of DASG and BMM training courses. Directed these checks be executed and tracked (EXHIBITS A, B, C).

3. RELEVANT LAW AND/OR POLICY.

a. The current policy governing training of Soldiers executing guard force missions at IMCOM Installations is derived from IMCOM Policy Memorandum - Installation Security Guard Certification and Annual Training Program, dated 29 November 2022 (EXHIBIT Y). Annex D lists the "Minimum Unit Mission Tasking (UMT) Soldier Training (EXHIBIT Y, page 11). Neither Anti-Terrorism nor Terrorism Awareness training is a minimum requirement.

b. Anti-Terrorism training is sanctioned by Army Regulation 350-1, Army Training and Leader Development. By AR 350-1, Anti-Terrorism Training is mandatory for all personnel (Soldiers, Army Civilians and contractors), the requirement is annually for Regular Army Soldiers. The authority reference for Anti-Terrorism is AR 525-13.

4. FINDINGS. I make the following findings by a preponderance of evidence.

a. I find that the Terror Awareness slides used to train BMM Soldiers on 10 July 2024, inaccurately listed non-profit, tax-exempt public advocacy organizations (National Right to Life, Operation Rescue, and PETA) as Terrorist Groups. Nowhere in AR 525-13, nor in any other training material or documentation does the Army state these groups are Terrorist Groups. No evidence suggests this mis-labeling reflected an official Army position or policy.

b. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) did not (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) refer to the groups listed on these slides as terrorist organizations when (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) training on 10 July 2024, nor at any other time before. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) used these slides to reference "Special interest" or "Single-issue" groups that may have members who may have extremist views and might commit acts of terrorism. I make this finding based on (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) of the slides and the recollection of the Soldiers who participated in the training.

c. Labeling the slides in question “Terrorist Groups” was a mistake (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) made when (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). Because the 2011 version of the presentation did not have graphics for “Special interest / Single-issue” groups, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) the internet and selected groups based on guidance received from (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to use open-source documentation. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) these groups into the presentation without paying attention to the slide title and without considering how this visually misrepresented (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was attempting to convey. I make this finding based on (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) of the slides during the training, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (and supporting evidence) of the presentation’s development and subsequent modification.

d. There is no evidence to suggest (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was attempting to deliberately subvert Army or Department of Defense (DoD) policy; nor is there any evidence to suggest (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) attempting to further a personal viewpoint through the Terror Awareness presentation.

e. The Terror Awareness presentation was neither reviewed nor approved by (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). The (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) developed the presentation and delivered the training. There is no evidence of a DES policy or standard operating procedure that directs a review or approval process for this or similar training presentations. I based this finding on the sworn statements of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C).

f. There is no evidence of similar training (e.g. discussing non-profit advocacy groups, pro-life beliefs, or animal rights when discussing terrorism) at Fort Liberty. I make this finding based on interviews with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and DES leadership. Specifically, their statements attest that this presentation was locally developed and maintained, and DES leadership asserts that this presentation was not distributed.

g. There is no evidence that the 2017 slides were acquired, shared, or presented outside of Fort Liberty. I make this finding based on sworn statements from the (b) (6), (b) (7)(C).

h. The current version of the Terror Awareness training has been used since 2017. From 2017 to July 2024, approximately 9,100 Soldiers have been trained. I make this finding based on interviews with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C).

i. After being made aware of inaccuracies in the Terror Awareness presentation the Fort Liberty DES took the following actions:

(1) Stopped teaching Terror Awareness as part of the BMM training.

(2) Directed a review of all DASG and BMM training to ensure it is presented and executed in accordance with DA policy, regulation, and guidance (completed 14 July 24).

(3) Directed appropriate (b) (5) of DASG and BMM training prior to execution (completed 16 July 24).

(4) Directed a re-validation of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) prior to the next BMM training course.

(5) Directed DES senior leader attendance at the next BMM training course.

(6) Directed periodic checks of DASG and BMM training courses.

(7) Directed these checks be tracked.

All Department of the Army Security Guard (DASG) and Unit Mission Tasking Soldier (Borrowed Military Manpower - BMM) training is conducted locally per IMCOM guidance and directives; there is no centralized academy or program of instruction (POI). IMCOM publishes the training requirements requirement for DASG and BMM.

In 2011 IMCOM published an order requiring Terror Awareness training for Soldiers working Access Control Points at Army Installations. (FRAGO 8 to IMCOM EXORD 10-001, page 4 minimum requirements)

In 2022 IMCOM updated the training requirements for Soldiers working in support of Installation Access Control and removed the Terror Awareness training requirement. (IMCOM Policy Memo - Minimum Manning Standard for all IMCOM Installation Access Control Points, page 13 for minimum requirements)

5. What actions did you or your division take after the presentation on 10 JUL 24?
I became aware that a slide with accompanying post from the FLNC DES Terror Awareness training was trending on "X" after PT on/about 0800 on 11 JUL 24. I was contacted by XVIII ABC leadership and (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to make me aware of the trending post. The XVIII ABC Commander asked me to determine the initial circumstances around the situation.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to come to my office at 0840 to better understand the situation. I had not seen the slides so wanted to review the slides used for training, understand how long they had been in use for, and what requirement/authority required/directed the training.

At that time, I was made aware the slides were developed by the FLNC Garrison AT/FP section some time in 2008 and had been in use by the FLNC DES since 2009. The slides were managed locally in the FLNC DES Physical Security Division and used to train BMM Soldiers in the access control mission task requirements based off FRAGO 08 to IMCOM EXORD 10-001 requirement from 2011.

Upon review of the slides and discussion with the (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) it was apparent to me the slide in question was taken out of context and unfortunately inaccurately and incorrectly labeled. The slide that immediately precedes the trending slide has groups from across a spectrum of beliefs and has an inaccurate and incorrectly labeled slide header identical to the slide that trended on the social media platform "X". The (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) The slides were periodically updated as different events happened to stay current and was most recently updated in 2017. I am not aware of these slides being shared with other installations.

During discussions that morning I became aware the training requirement from IMCOM was updated in 2022 removing the "Terror Awareness" class as a training requirement. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)

- The Terror Awareness training will not be executed as it is not required by 2022 IMCOM Policy Memo. BMM Soldiers will be required to be current on their Antiterrorism Level 1 mandatory training, managed at the unit level and in accordance with regulatory requirements.
- Review of all DASG and BMM training to ensure it is presented and executed in accordance with DA policy, regulation, and guidance (completed 14 JUL 24)
- The DES will ensure DASG and BMM training receive appropriate (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) prior to execution. (completed 16 JUL 24)
- The DES will re-validate DASG BMM instructors prior to the next BMM training course and have DES senior leader attendance at the next BMM training course. Periodic checks of DASG and BMM training courses will be executed and tracked. (Revalidation of instructors scheduled to be completed 22-26 JUL; DES senior leader presence scheduled/directed at BMM training 5-9 AUG 24).

6. Please describe any additional information that you think could be relevant to the investigation.

BMM Soldiers are part of most installation access control plans because there are not enough DASG or MP at each installation to provide access control organically. The amount of BMM varies based on Senior Commander priorities for security and installation access (ACP Personnel Requirement).

IMCOM directs the training required for DASG and BMM Soldiers in the execution of their access control missions. At FLNC the XVIII ABC publishes an order tasking units for BMM to conduct the access control mission and tasks the Garrison/DES to train BMM for the access control mission. The BMM Soldiers come from local units and the mission is non-MOS specific. The FLNC DES Physical Security Section trains approximately 1,000 BMM Soldiers to perform the Access Control mission annually.

The BMM ACP training is approximately two weeks with one week of classroom and OC Spray training and one week of on-the-job training to validate the classroom training. (BMM Training Plan).

The BMM ACP are trained to orient the Soldiers to the access control mission, the specific tasks and technical skills required to execute the mission, and to ensure the Soldiers understand the threats and incidents they may encounter during the course of executing their duties. The training is combination of IMCOM Training Requirements and local requirements.

Local requirements for DASG and BMM training exist for a few reasons. BMM tasked include the full spectrum of MOSS; local requirements account for baselining the Soldiers that execute the mission if the tasks are not part of their regular duties and the flexibility to local leadership to focus training based on the unique characteristics of the installation. The threat to installations varies so the context of the ACP mission is not the same for all installations. Additionally, the physical construct and technical capability of the scanning/identification system is not the same for each ACP or for each installation. Specificity related to tactical and technical employment of personnel and equipment at each ACP is important and cannot be completely standardized across installations. Additionally, laws vary from state to state and jurisdiction varies as well. Some states have concurrent jurisdiction, and some states have local/state exclusive and federal exclusive jurisdiction. The jurisdiction that exists for each installation can impact actions that ACP Personnel (DASG and BMM) may take at the ACP.

Examples of external agencies that provide training include the 16th MP BDE SARC for SHARP training to set a baseline expectation of professionalism during mission execution, Federal Litigation SJA for Authority and Jurisdiction, Rules of Evidence, and Search & Seizure to baseline BMM Soldiers on appropriate federal and state laws that will impact their actions at the Access Control Points.

Terror Awareness training was no longer mandated by IMCOM in 2022. My impression was the Terror Awareness training was left in the BMM ACP training to demonstrate the importance of remaining alert and aware during a security mission that can often seem mundane until it is not.

The **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** in the DES are responsible for the training in their sections, particularly individual training. Requirements for training are directed by IMCOM, however, there are no standardized training materials provided by IMCOM for standard, mandated tasks. Training is left to local installations for development and execution.

4. Are you aware of any policies, guidance, or SOP's governing or directing the Fort Liberty DES Terror Awareness training? If so, what are they? A: There was an IMCOM order that was published in 2011/2012 that directed specific training (Included Terrorism Awareness) for the DASG program when it was formed after the Contract with Wackenhut Security was terminated -specific date unknown. I believe the entire training program was sent to IMCOM for approval.

5. What actions did (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) take after the presentation on 10 JUL 24? A: Once DES was aware that a specific picture of one of the slides from the Terror Awareness training was posted on social media (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to investigate the situation but didn't have much to go on but the picture provided to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) There was no verbiage or content addressing the specific slide or any concerns from the (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) Social media comments on the specific photo circulating on social media without knowing the content or sitting in on the training doesn't accurately reflect what was taught during the training course. Personnel often try to put a negative spin on things to fit their narrative or make comments without knowing all the facts. DES acknowledges that the slide header for that series within the training program should have been changed to more accurately reflect that section of the training program - this would have helped alleviate any misunderstanding to what was being taught. DES immediately started to look into the situation and evaluate this and all other training programs for our BMM guard force. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) directed that we do not use this slide deck anymore and the (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) need to look over all training materials for accurate content. We are still in the process of evaluating all our training programs. DES is working to develop a training material vetting process. This process will flow from the slide deck originator to the training branch to the specific division chief. Once the division chief validates the training program it will be presented to the deputy and director for final approval. The training program may also be sent to legal or others for approval if necessary. Each division within DES has training personnel that are considered SMEs in their respective fields and are responsible to ensure training content is relevant for our personnel. They are responsible to update content as necessary based off changes in policy or new guidance provided by other Government Agencies. For the Terror Awareness program - (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) all of which you have interviewed.

6. Please describe any additional information that you think could be relevant to the investigation. A: I believe the original slide deck was created prior to 2010 by (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) The slide deck was used to train DES personnel. From my understanding the last significant update to the slide deck occurred around 2017. There was a slide deck name change in 2023 from Bragg to Liberty. Updates or content changes to our training programs are done by qualified and trained personnel. All training content and updates to the terror awareness program were done with and from references found in open source materials/documents provided and or published by Government Agencies like the FBI, DHS, DNI, CIA, and other counter-terrorism experts.

There is a lead in slide in the training program that discussed Special interest / Single Issue Groups that have a specific focus to get their agenda across and try to sway or alter peoples view points. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) that people try to use these groups to help push their specific agendas or causes. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) tries to explain that some people may try to take advantage of these groups and was trying to show that these groups can be targets themselves. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) never has (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) Anti-Abortion Groups were Terrorist Groups. An example of one reference source used for material content is the FBI and DHS document Titled; Strategic Intelligence Assessment and Data on Domestic Terrorism. This document has a subsection from Office of the Director of National Intelligence that list a section Titled - Intelligence Community Categories (not organizations) of Domestic Violent Extremists; one in particular is titled Abortion-Related Violent Extremists, DVEs with ideological agendas in support of Pro-life and Pro-choice beliefs.

During the transition from the IMCOM slide template in 2017 (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) review the Terror Awareness course instruction. Our Physical Security Programs have been inspected by the DAIG, IMCOM HQ PS, and numerous Staff Assisted visits by IMCOM Security Professionals. In addition to IMCOM HQ, FORSCOM Protection has twice reviewed our programs in the last five years. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) numerous laudatory comments from IMCOM and OPMG for providing excellent results during our ACP and Physical Security programs. I will continue to improve our program and ensure this type of incident doesn't repeat itself by engaging all courses of instruction with a more rigorous review process outlined in a directorate policy.
