With the exception of the *Lewis* case in the Eighth Circuit, each of these cases involves a suit seeking relief

against anti-abortion picketing or obstruction at abortion facilities. *Lewis* is a suit by a woman alleging that a pro-life crisis pregnancy center wrongfully hindered her efforts to obtain an abortion.
